Visitor Parking Policy & Passes



Effective June 1, 2014, Radwyn Apartments' new visitor parking policy will go to into effect.

- All residents need to display parking passes on rear view mirrors.
- If you loose your tag, please stop by the office for a new one now. Moving forward, there will be a \$20 charge for a replacement tag.
- **All visitors need parking passes.** Free Visitor Passes are available. Your visitors need to display these passes so management knows they have permission to park. **Don't forget to collect them** as your guests depart!
- All visitors must park away from the buildings. Help us preserve the closest spots for residents.
- **Vehicles without passes will be towed for your safety!** Once the towing company tows your car, we cannot reverse the charges. All fees will be at the expense of the car owner.

- Dogs must be on a leash in all outdoor areas, with the exception of the doggy park. To guarantee the safety of your dog as well as the safety of our other residents, there is a fine of \$100 for dogs off leash.
- Let's keep our dogs quiet so as not to disturb other residents. We understand that dogs sometimes bark. Please try to limit noise.

Outdoor Living Spaces, Balconies & Patios

We want Radwyn residents to enjoy our acreage, trees, sunshine, fresh air and wild life. Please keep your balconies and patios free of clutter. You are welcome to place tables, chairs and a potted plant or two on your balconies or patios. However, the following are prohibited: hanging laundry, bikes, storage of trash/trash cans and any kind of grill. These can be unsightly, and grills are a fire hazard. Avoid fines by keeping your balcony or patio tidy and free of these items. These spaces are for enjoying, not storage. A Great Recipe to Stay Cool This Summer: Very Berry Breakfast

Ingredients

1 c frozen unsweetened raspberries
3/4 c chilled unsweetened almond or rice milk
1/4 c frozen pitted unsweetened cherries or raspberries
1/2 tbsp honey
2 tsp finely grated fresh ginger
1 tsp ground flaxseed
2 tsp fresh lemon juice
Servings: 2

Combine all ingredients in blender, adding lemon juice to taste. Puree until smooth. Pour into 2 chilled glasses.
