History of Halloween...Origins of the Halloween Costume

Early Halloween costumes were designed by the Celts to protect the wearers from the dead, and were designed to be as gruesome as possible. These Halloween costumes were not pleasant to look at as they were intended to scare spirits away. Costumes were always home-made, and people would spend a great deal of time perfecting theirs in time for Halloween.

Most costumes were made from animal skins, and many would wear animal heads as masks. Others would simply fashion masks from plants, skins and trees and make them look as evil as possible.

This gruesome traditional remained even when the Romans occupied parts of Great Britain and other areas where the Celts lived perhaps because the Romans also loved their costumes and celebrated two festivals around that time of the year - one to remember the dead and another to celebrate Pomona, the Roman goddess of fruits and trees. 
